

Abstract pattern – General requirements

Please read these instructions carefully!

Deadline for submission is extended till 10 January 2020.

General instructions:

The number of pages should not exceed 3 pages and 3 MB.

Each page should be a single column on European A 4 size (210mm x 297mm).

The margins have to be set up as follows:

Top margin to the first line: 2.5 cm

Bottom margin to the last line: 3.5 cm

Left margin to the text: 2.5 cm

Right margin to the text: 2.5 cm

Font sizes:

Please ensure that all fonts and pictures or tables are embedded in the final PDF-file.

Please use single spacing for the text, 3 pt spacing before line and justify the text (i.e. align the text to both the left and the right margins).

We recommend to use the following abstract pattern to produce your abstract for PCIM Asia.

Preferred Presentation Form: Oral or Poster Presentation

Abstract (Header 1, 12 pt, bold)

Here you are requested to write the abstract of your paper. The abstract should state briefly and clearly the purpose, methods, results and conclusions of the work. This abstract should not be more than maximum 100 words.

Synopsis (Header 1, 12 pt, bold)

Here, you start to write the synopsis (short form) of the real paper. It consists of an introduction, the body of the text with the different paragraphs, including figures, formulae, tables and eventual images, and the conclusion.

The synopsis is an extended summary of your work. Start by describing the problem your work addresses. Describe your work and how it contributes to the solution of the problem. Include, if relevant, as much evidence of completed experimental as possible.

The guidelines and requirements for a synopsis submitted to PCIM Asia are:

- Papers must be original material and must not have been presented or published previously.
- The synopsis should give a clear and precise statement of the purpose and contribution of the work, specific results and the methods used. Include key equations, figures, tables and experimental results.
- All authors should obtain company and governmental clearance prior to submission of the synopsis.
- Synopses marked or labeled as "Confidential", "Proprietary" or with similar wording will not be accepted.
- Synopses can be submitted in any version of Adobe Acrobat.pdf
- Number all pages of the synopsis.
